The Greatest Ever!

Our devotions this week are focused upon the Faithfulness of God. Often when the Bible describes the Faithfulness of God there is another "truth" attached to help us better appreciate and understand how God demonstrates his faithfulness in our lives.

Day One

For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your faithfulness reaches to the skies. Psalm 57:10

- What "truth" is attached to God's Faithfulness in this verse?
- How far does the love of God reach?
- What do you think it means that God's love reaches to the heavens?
- What do you think it means that God's faithfulness reaches to the skies?
- We cannot separate the love of God and the faithfulness of God. How has God been faithful in demonstrating his love for you?
- Take a minute and tell God thanks for His faithfulness in loving you.

Day Two

Faithfulness springs forth from the earth, and righteousness looks down from heaven. Psalm 85:11

- What “truth” is God’s faithfulness attached to in this verse?
- How does God demonstrate his faithfulness through his righteousness?
- What do you think it means that faithfulness springs forth from the earth?
- What do you think it means that righteousness looks down from the heavens?
- This Psalm is about the hope of God’s blessing and restoration. It says that god keeps his promises (faithful) and does what is right (righteousness).
- In what ways has God been faithful to do what is right in your life?
- Take a minute and ask God to reveal how He has been faithful in doing right in your life. .

Day Three

He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. Psalm 91:4

- What “truth” is God’s faithfulness attached to in this verse?
- How do the protection and covering of God show His faithfulness?

- How does God's faithfulness act as a shield and rampart? (rampart = barricade)
- Take a few minutes and list 5 areas where God will be faithful to you today. Try finishing this sentence. ***If everything else in life went wrong today God still...***

Day Four

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. Hebrews 13:10

- What "truth" is attached to God's Faithfulness in this verse?
- How is our confidence impacted by God's faithfulness?
- What does it mean to "hold unswervingly" to something?
- What are we told to hold unswervingly to?
- What does it look like to hold unswervingly to "the hope we profess"?
- What reason is given for holding unswervingly to the hope we profess?
- Take a few minutes and list 3-4 promises God has kept in your life and thank Him.

Day Five

I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. Revelation 19:11

- What "truth" is attached to God's Faithfulness in this verse?
- What is the rider of the horse called in this verse?
- What does it mean that God is "TRUE?"
- The "trueness" of God means that he is always fair, right and just even when he is not understood.
- What way does this verse say God uses his "Faithful and true" moniker?
- Is there a way that God's Faithful and True description impacts your life?
- List 2 way God has been faithful and true in your life and thank Him.

Prayer of Commitment

Dear Jesus, you are HANDS DOWN the greatest ever. Your Faithfulness reaches to the skies. You have been faithful in ways I cannot see and in way I have seen clearly.
