Our devotions this week are focused upon the truth that God is the **Only Wise God**. Wisdom is a combination of knowing the best outcome as well as the best way to accomplish that outcome. Our God is without measure or equal in His wisdom. Or as we like to say around here he is HANS DOWN, the Wisest ever!

Day One

Great is our Lord and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite. Psalm 147:5

- What three descriptions are given about "our" LORD?
- "His understanding is infinite," what does this phrase tell us about the wisdom of God?
- How does the fact that God's wisdom is beyond limits and measureless impact your trust in God?
- List one or two ways in which God's wisdom has shown itself in your life recently.
- Take a few minutes to give God thanks for His wisdom.

Day Two

How many are your works, O LORD! In wisdom you

***made them all; the earth is full of your creatures.
Psalm 104:24***

- What did God use to accomplish all His works?
- This statement is designed to be a declaration of worship to God. Take a minute and make three statements of worship to God beginning with these words.
- Your Wisdom Oh LORD...
- From the verse, do you think the wisdom of God leaves anything to accident or chance?
- What does that say about how God works in your life?
- Take a minute and ask God to help you see His Wisdom more clearly in your life.

Day Three

***Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!
Romans 11:33***

- What is being extolled in this verse?
- What does it say is unsearchable?
- What does it mean that His judgments are unsearchable?
- What does the verse say is beyond tracing out?

- What does it mean his ways are beyond tracing out?
- We sometimes get frustrated when someone is beyond our understanding or their ways are mysterious. Does this author seem frustrated?
- Take a few minutes and ask God to help you appreciate The greatness of His wisdom and knowledge.

Day Four

Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. 1 Timothy 1:17NKJV

- What are some of the characteristics that are given to describe God in this verse?
- Because of God's attributes in this verse, what is to be given to God?
- How does one go about giving God the Honor due Him?
- How does one go about giving God the glory due Him?
- How would using the "wisdom of God" bring glory and honor to God?
- Take a few minutes and ask God to help you use His wisdom.

Day Five

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. James 1:5

- What does this verse say we should do when we lack wisdom?
- How will God respond to our request for wisdom?
- What two descriptions are given to how God give out His wisdom?
- Take a minute and ask God for wisdom for your life.
